### Mass Times

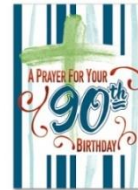
Tuesday 14 August 7:00pm

*Holy Days of obligation for Australia are 15 August (Assumption) and 25 December (Christmas). The importance of a day in the liturgical calendar is determined by its rank (solemnity, feast, memorial); a Holy Day is simply a solemnity celebrated like a Sunday, that is, with obligation.*
