### Fr Stan writes ...

Today, **PALM SUNDAY of the PASSION of the LORD**, we enter into the most solemn week of the Church's year. Lent ends on **Holy Thursday** before the Mass of the Lord's Supper when we enter into the Easter Triduum. The term Triduum means "three days". The three days are counted from dusk to dusk beginning at sundown on Holy Thursday. Each of these days tells a different story of Jesus' saving action. On **Holy Thursday**, we remember the Last Supper. Jesus gives us the Eucharist and tells us to "Do this in memory of me". He then washes the feet of the Apostles. It is also the institution of the sacerdotal priesthood (as distinct from the "priesthood of believers") for in this, his last supper with the disciples, celebration of Passover, he is the self-offered Passover Victim, and every ordained priest to this day presents this same sacrifice, by Christ's authority and command, in exactly the same way. On **Good Friday**, we remember the passion and death of Jesus. We celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ either at the **Easter Vigil** on Saturday night or on **Easter Sunday**. We look at the Easter Triduum as one celebration that lasts for three days.

**STATIONS of the CROSS** this afternoon, **PALM SUNDAY 25<sup>th</sup> MARCH at 2:30pm** at **MACQUARIE PARK CEMETERY**. This service will take place in the beautiful sculpture park at the Stations of the Cross, led by our Parish Priest, Fr Stan. There is plenty of undercover seating ... so rain, hail or shine ... they will go ahead!



For the **Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening at 7:30pm**, you are reminded to bring along your Project Compassion Boxes and place them in the basket provided in the foyer so that they can be part of our presentation of the gifts.

**GOOD FRIDAY ANNUAL COLLECTION** for the support of the Church in the Holy Land takes place on Good Friday. This collection promotes the missionary work of the Church in the Holy Land. Please remember the Christians of the Holy Land once again this Good Friday. Thank you.

**DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY – SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER: Mass** and devotions in our parish on Divine Mercy Sunday, **8<sup>th</sup> April at 2:30pm**. The Novena leading up to the Feast, will commence on Good Friday in the church following the Commemoration of the Lord's Passion at 3:00pm. The Novena continues on Holy Saturday at 9:30am, Easter Sunday following the evening Mass; Easter Monday (2<sup>nd</sup> April) following the 8:30am Mass; Easter Tuesday following the 7:00pm Mass, then through to Saturday (7 April) following Mass.

**BLESSING of the EASTER FOOD BASKETS** will take place on Holy Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> March at 10:00am.
