COMPASSION

Fr Stan writes ...

Today, **PALM SUNDAY** of the **PASSION** of the **LORD**, we enter into the most solemn week of the Church's year. Lent ends on **Holy Thursday** before the Mass of the Lord's Supper when we enter into the **Easter Triduum – The Three Days**. Each of these days tells a different story of Jesus' saving action. On **Holy Thursday** we remember the Last Supper. Jesus gives us the Eucharist. He then washes the feet of the Apostles. It is also the institution of the sacerdotal priesthood (as distinct from the "priesthood of believers") for in this, his last supper with the disciples, celebration of Passover, he is the self-offered Passover Victim, and every ordained priest to this day presents this same sacrifice, by Christ's authority and command, in exactly the same way. On **Good Friday** we remember the passion and death of Jesus. We celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ either at the **Easter Vigil** on Saturday night or on **Easter Sunday**. We look at the Easter Triduum as one celebration that lasts for three days.

STATIONS of the CROSS this afternoon, **PALM SUNDAY 14TH APRIL at 2:30pm at MACQUARIE PARK CEMETERY**. This service will take place in the beautiful sculpture park at the Stations of the Cross, led by our Parish Priest, Fr Stan. There is plenty of undercover seating ... so rain, hail or shine ... they will go ahead.

The journey for our **RCIA Elect**, Harin Premaratne, Anunt Pongngamjit and Skyler Liyuan Huang, climaxes at the Easter Vigil when they will receive the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. A light supper will follow the Easter Vigil where it will afford you the opportunity to meet them and congratulate them. **A plate of 'goodies' would be appreciated to help with the catering. May be left at the parish centre before Mass. Please continue to pray for them.**

BLESSING of the EASTER FOOD BASKETS will take place on Holy Saturday (20th April) at 10:00am.

GOOD FRIDAY ANNUAL COLLECTION for the support of the Church in the Holy Land takes place on Good Friday. This collection promotes the missionary work of the Church in the Holy Land. Please remember the Christians of the Holy Land once again this Good Friday. Thank you.

The Novena continues on Holy Saturday at 9:30am, Easter Sunday following the evening Mass, then through Easter week to Easter Saturday (27 April) following Mass.
