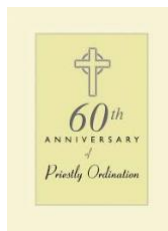

## Fr Stan writes ...

**Why do we make the sign of the cross?** Do you rush through the sign of the cross as if swatting a fly? Don't! This gesture contains powerful symbolism connected with the Trinity and with your baptism. Indeed, it can be viewed as a prayer in itself. By making this sign you are declaring: *I am completely under the power of the risen Christ, our Redeemer.* You are identifying yourself with generations of Christians, for the common usage of the familiar formula – *In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.* Amen – can be traced back to the second century.
